

Complete Concussion Management™ Baseline Testing Registration Instructions

Your team or sports organization is undergoing baseline concussion assessment through Complete Concussion Management™ this season. You should have been given a “payment code” by either your coach, your association, or the clinic that will be conducting the testing. If you have not received a payment code please contact your coach or association to acquire one.

Once you have received a “payment code”:

1. Visit: **network.completeconcussions.com/register**
2. Enter all personal information for the athlete that is to be tested as well as the “payment code” you were issued and a contact email. The contact email can be that of a parent or guardian.
3. Click “Register Athlete” (blue box at the bottom of the page)
4. On the next page, enter all of your information and select “Add and Continue” at the bottom of the page.
5. On the next page confirm that your information is correct and select “confirm”. If your information is not correct, please contact tech support at support@completeconcussions.com
6. Write down your account number on the next page and put it somewhere for safekeeping. Your account number will also be sent to the email address you provided. Do not lose this number!
7. At your assigned time (your coach or association will notify you of your time), attend your assigned clinic to complete your baseline concussion test!

Baseline concussion testing is a very important step that must be taken prior to engaging in any high-risk sport. This testing consists of various tests of function (i.e., balance, reaction time, vision, memory, concentration, etc.) that could become impaired following a concussion injury. The results of your baseline test are utilized should you become injured in order to aid in proper diagnosis as well as to determine when you have fully recovered from your concussion and are now safe to return to your sport.
